

# WEST AFRICA Ebola Outbreak

## Early Symptoms:

Ebola can only be spread to others after symptoms begin. Symptoms can appear from 2 to 21 days after exposure.

- **Fever**
- **Headache**
- **Diarrhea**
- **Vomiting**
- **Stomach pain**
- **Muscle pain**
- **Unexplained bleeding or bruising**
